# PCLC AT VAN GAME PREVIEW

The Panther City Lacrosse Club (3-3) will head to the great North to face the Saskatchewan Rush (1-4) on Saturday, February 3 at 7 p.m. on ESPN+ / TSN+, after a record-setting performance last week against the Las Vegas Desert Dogs that saw the club break multiple franchise records, while PCLC players also set personal and franchise records for single game performances.

Panther City defeated the Desert Dogs, 21-12 last Saturday and en route to the victory scored 15 first half goals, the most in a half in NLL history and the 21 goals were the most goals scored in franchise history. Panther City has eclipsed the 20-goal mark three times in franchise history and did so once last season and was one of four teams to do so. No team has scored 20+ goals this season in the NLL other than PCLC. The 21 goals were not the only franchise record that was broken as the team set new records for points (58), assists (37), power play assists (11) and tied their record for most power play goals (6).

Individually, Panther City was led by **Callum Crawford** who recorded 14 points (8G/6A) on the evening. He became the only player in NLL history to record multiple 14-point games as he tied his career high (prev: 12/27/19 NE vs. NY). His eight goals set a new career high, of which he became the 7th player in league history to record at least 8 goals in a game and his 12 first-half points are the most in a half in NLL history. Crawford was appearing in his 250th career game and became only the 18th player in league history to accomplish this.

Joining Crawford in the scoring spree was fourth-year forward **Will Malcom** who recorded 12 points (4G/8A), of which his eight assists tie a career high that he set nearly a year ago (1/28/23 at VAN). **Phil Caputo** set a career high with five goals. Second-year forward **Mathieu Gautier** set a career high with seven assists and five PCLC plauers recorded at least six points (Crawford - 14, Malcom - 12, Donville - 8, Gautier - 8 & Caputo - 6).

Saskatchewan enters the contest having only played in five games and has some new faces on either end. Former Panther City player Patrick Dodds, Mike Triolo and Cameron Wengreniuk are all members of the Rush. Veteran goalie Frank Scigliano, formerly of San Diego, continues his career in Saskatoon and has made 191 saves thus far this season. Zach Manns leads offensively (28 points - 14G/14A) and Mike Messenger leads the D with 11 CTOs.



The team was led by Will Malcom who recorded eight points, including tying his career high with five goals, while adding three assists. Jonathan Donville, who is second in the NLL in assists, led the club with five assists and also added two goals for a total of seven points.

Panther City's transition duo of Tony Malcom and Josh Medeiros were crucial for Panther City this evening as Malcom led the team with three caused turnovers, tied for the team lead with nine loose balls and also added a goal. Medeiros recorded two fourth-quarter goals and also scooped up five loose balls. Panther City held the advantage 76-67 in regards to loose balls on the evening.

Defensively, Nick Damude turned away 37 of the 47 shots (.787 save percentage) he faced on the evening. Damude who has found his offensive stroke recently also recorded two assists, after scoring a goal in Colorado last weekend. Panther City's captain, Matt Hossack recorded nine loose balls and also caused two turnovers. The defense as a unit forced 16 turnovers.

### Blackjack!

Against the Las Vegas Desert Dogs (1/27/24), Panther City broke their franchise record for goals in a single game as they scored 21 goals. It is the only 20+ goal game in the NLL this season and PCLC has accomplished 20+ goals three times in their three years, including being one of four teams to record 20+ goals last year.

In addition to the goals record, the team also set franchise records for points (58), assists (37) and power play assists (11). Their six power play goals tied a franchise record.

### Callum Crawford, Ladies and Gentlemen

Callum Crawford had a historic performance against the Las Vegas Desert Dogs last Saturday (1/27). Below are his accomplishments from that game:

- Became the only player in NLL history to record multiple 14-point games (Prev: 12/27/19 NE vs. NY).
- Tied his career high with 14 points (8G/6A).
- Set a new career high with 8 goals.
- Became the 7th player in NLL history to record at least 8 goals in a single regular season game
- His 12 first-half points (6G/6A) are the most points scored in a half in league history.
- Became the 18th player in league history to appear in at least 250 career games.
- Named the NLL Player of the Week (Week 9) First PCLC player to ever win Player of the Week honors.

### **Special Teams Success**

Panther City currently is 2nd in the NLL on the power play having scored 19 goals on their 32 man advantages (59%). Their 19 goals are the most power play goals in the NLL through nine weeks of play.

Forward Phil Caputo is the franchise leader in power play goals having scored 26 goals on the man advantage in 39 career games. Caputo has led the team in power play goals the past two seasons and currently leads the team with six power play goals, which is tied for second most in the NLL.

### **Knocking On the Door To Success**

Rookie forward Jason Knox had the best game of his young career against New York (1/13) recording 5 points (4G/1A), of which included a power play goal and assist. His four goals led PCLC on the evening.

For his efforts, Knox was named the NLL Rookie of the Week (Week 7). Panther City has now had a rookie win Rookie of the Week at least once in every year of their existence.

### **Caputo Consistency**

Forward Phil Caputo has scored a goal in every game thus far in the 2023-24 season (6 games). He currently has an 13-game goal scoring streak dating back to last season, as the last time he did not record a goal was back on 2/24/23.

Caputo is second in Panther City franchise history with 68 goals. Will Malcom leads the way with 71 goals.

### **Crawf Continues To Crush**

In 16 games with PCLC, Crawford has now scored five or more goals in a single game three times.

In Week 9 against Las Vegas, Crawford recorded eight goals, his fifth game this season with three or more goals. Crawford has recorded seven hat tricks in 16 career games with Panther City.

Crawford is currently 5th in the NLL in points (42) and tied with Georgia's Lyle Thompson for the league lead in goals scored (23), while playing in one less game.

### **Callum Chasing Greatness**

Against Las Vegas (12/10), Crawford scored his 460th career goal, which gave him sole possesion of 10th place all time in NLL history for most goals scored, passing Mark Steenhuis. Crawford needs three goals to surpass Shawn Evans for 9th place all time on the goals scored list.

Crawford became the eighth player in NLL history to record 1,200 points in his career against Las Vegas (12/10). Through 250 career games, Crawford now ranks in the top 10 all time in NLL history for goals (10th - 477 goals), assists (7th - 758 assists) and points (8th - 1,235 points). Crawford is one of two current active players (HFX Ryan Benesch) that are in the top 10 offensively all time statistically in NLL history.

### **Dynamic Duo**

With Callum Crawford's 14 points and Will Malcom's 12 points against Las Vegas (1/27), the PCLC pair tied an NLL record for most combined points between a set of teammates (26). They tied Mark Steenhuis (17 points) and Cory Bomberry (9 points) who accomplished this feat in 2009. (h/t Graeme Perrow / @NLLStats)

### Milestones Reached

Forward Jonathan Doville recorded his 100th career point against Las Vegas (12/10) in just his 20th NLL game.

Forward Will Malcom recorded his 200th career point against Toronto on 12/22 as he recorded five points (2G/3A).

Will Malcom will surpassed 200 career points in a Panther City uniform against Las Vegas (1/27). In his debut season with PCLC, Malcom notched 81 points, only to then set the franchise record for points in a single season in year two with the club (96 points). He currently has 34 points in 2023-24.

### **Roaring Rookies**

Under the direction of General Manager Bob Hamley and Head Coach Tracey Kelusky, Panther City has had five different players win the NLL Rookie of the Week honors for a total of 11 times (J. Donville 5x, P.Dodds: 3x, D. Fairall, M. Gautier & J. Knox)

### **Malcom Making Moves**

Since joining the Panther City Lacrosse Club, forward Will Malcom has been one of the club's most consistent offensive threats. Malcom has recorded a point in every game he has played in in a Panther City jersey (40 games) and has scored a goal in 36 of the 40 games he has played in.

### **Rookie of the Year Records**

Jonathan Donville's 67 assists last season were the second-most ever by a rookie in NLL history and only trailed New York's Jeff Teat (71 - 2022).

### **Goalie Goals Squared**

Goalie Nick Damude recorded his second career goal at Colorado (2/24). His first career goal also came against Colorado (3/11/22). Damude is the only goalie to score a goal in the NLL over the past two seasons and the first since Doug Jamieson (New England) on 4/27/19.

Damude is now one of five goalies in NLL history to score more than one goal in their careers. Rob Blasdell leads all goalies in NLL history with four goals scored.

### Legendary Lax

Against Vancouver (1/28/23), Jonathan Donville recorded 12 points (4G/8A), which were the second most points scored in a single game in NLL history by a rookie, tying NLL legend Gary Gait.

### **Thou Shall Not Cross**

Goalie Nick Damude had a career night last season against Las Vegas (12/16/22), allowing a career-low three goals and recording a career-high .909 save percentage. Damude stopped 30 of the 33 shots he faced on the night. His previous career-low of goals allowed was six, against the Mammoth on 3/26/22.

Damude narrowly missed the NLL record for fewest goals allowed in a single game (2). He blanked the Desert Dogs in both the first and fourth quarter. With that performance, Damude became just the fifth goalie in NLL history to allow three or fewer goals in a full regular-season game.



# BOB HAMLEY

# GENERAL MANAGER & VICE PRESIDENT OF LACROSSSE OPERATIONS

Bob Hamley, a 20-year plus veteran of the National Lacrosse League, serves as the Vice President of Lacrosse Operations and General Manager for the Panther City Lacrosse Club. He joined the club in September of 2020.

Hamley is responsible for the hiring of Head Coach Tracey Kelusky, the 2022 Les Bartley NLL Coach of the Year winner and through his roster construction helped Panther City qualify to their first double-digit win campaign, tallying a 10-8 record and qualifying for the playoffs for the first time in franchise history by finishing as the third seed in the Western Conference in 2022-23. In their inaugural season, Panther City recorded more wins than the previous two NLL expansion clubs' first seasons combined, as

Panther City won seven games, including a five-game winning streak. For his efforts in 2021-22, Hamley was named a finalist for the 2022 NLL General Manger of the Year Award.

Hamley's ability to scout and develop talent, while also acquiring and signing impact players has been at the forefront of Panther City's success and allowed the team to be competitive from their very first day. He drafted Jonathan Donville first overall with the team's first ever NLL Entry Draft selection in 2021. Donville took home the NLL Rookie of the Year award in 2022-23 after leading all rookies in points (90), which were the fourth-most ever by a rookie in NLL history, and assists (67), which were the second-most ever by a rookie in NLL history. He finished second amongst rookies with 23 goals. For his efforts, Donville was named NLL Rookie of the Week five times this past season, more than any other rookie in the league. Donville finished 9th in the NLL with 67 assists and his 29 power play assists were the most in the league and he finished tied for second in the NLL with 31 power play points. Under the direction of Hamley, Panther City, in its short history has had four different players win the NLL Rookie of the Week honors for a total of 10 times (Donville 5x, Patrick Dodds: 3x, Dean Fairall & Mathieu Gautiuer). In 2021-22, Hamley acquired four rookies who finished in the top-20 in rookie points, including All-Rookie Team member, Patrick Dodds, who finished second amongst rookies in scoring in 2021-22.

Hamley has also had success outside of the draft, acquiring or signing players that have had made an instant impact on the team and asserted themselves as some of the best at their position in the NLL. Will Malcom was acquired prior to the 2021-22 season and in 2022-23, Malcom led the team with 96 points (35G/61A), which was the first 90+ point season in franchise history and his goals and assists totals were both top 15 in the league. Goalie Nick Damude was also a key acquisition for Hamley as the goalie has improved each year since arriving in Panther City. Last season, Damude finished third in the NLL in Goals Against Average (GAA) with a GAA of 10.31. Damude allowed the fewest goals in a single game in the '22-23 season when he only allowed three goals against Las Vegas on 12/16, which made him only the fifth goalie in NLL history to allow three or fewer goals in a full regular-season game. Also defensively, Hamley acquired defenseman Matt Hossack in the 2021 NLL Expansion Draft. Hossack finished seventh in the NLL in caused turnovers (28) in 2022-23, while also recording 111 loose balls. Transition Player Josh Medeiros was signed as a free agent prior to the start of Panther City's inaugural season and in 2022-23 led all transition players with 21 goals, nearly tripling his rookie season goal output (8 goals in '21-22), en route to numerous career highs such as goals, loose balls (91) and caused turnovers (12).



# GENERAL MANAGER & VICE PRESIDENT OF LACROSSSE OPERATIONS

Hamley played in the NLL for four years and won back-to-back championships with the Buffalo Bandits in 1992-1993. Following his playing career, Hamley has enjoyed a successful run as Head Coach and or General Manager for 16 years throughout the league.

Prior to joining Panther City, Hamley served as the National Director of 3D Lacrosse in Georgia where he was responsible for the company's day-to-day operations. Here he helped develop the game of lacrosse, young players and coaches in market and assisted high school lacrosse players pursue scholarships at the collegiate level. Through Hamley's extensive nation-wide lacrosse network he was able to help place players at Michigan, John's Hopkins, Albany and Air Force.

From 2010-2014, Hamley was the Head Coach and Director of Player Personnel for the Colorado Mammoth. The team made the playoffs every year of Hamley's tenure and he was a part of the personnel department that drafted 2011 NLL Rookie of the Year Adam Jones. From 2008-2009, Hamley served as the Head Coach and General Manager for the Edmonton Rush.

Hamley was named the Head Coach and General Manager of the Columbus Landsharks in 2002 and remained with the team as they relocated to Arizona as the Arizona Sting. He remained with the team until 2008. During his tenure with the Sting, Hamley was named the Head Coach and General Manager of the Year in 2005, the first time the award was given to the one person in the same year. The team made the NLL Western Finals three straight years from 2005-07 and reached the championship game in 2005 and 2007.

In 2001, Hamley received his first shot on the bench as he was named an assistant coach with the Albany Attack. The team reached the NLL Championship game in his first season.

The Owen Sound, Ontario native currently resides in Fort Worth with his wife, Lisa and the couple have two children, Brock and Kelsea.



# TRACEY KELUSKY

**HEAD COACH** 

Tracey Kelusky (20-21) enters his third season as the Head Coach of the Panther City Lacrosse Club.

In 2022-23, in his second season at the helm of Panther City, Kelusky led the team to 10 wins, the first double-digit wins campaign in franchise history and also secured a playoff spot in just the team's second season, by finishing in third place in the Western Conference. As a team, Kelusky oversaw a power-play unit that finished fourth in the NLL and recorded the second-most power play goals (44). Kelusky also oversaw the development of 2023 NLL Rookie of the Year Jonathan Donville who led all rookies in points (90) and assists (67), while leading the NLL with 29 power play assists. Kelusky was also instrumental in the growth

of third-year forward Will Malcom who finished the season with 96 points (35G/61A) and became the first player in Panther City Lacrosse Club history to record a 90+ point season. Defensively, goalie Nick Damude took a massive step forward this season and helped lead the team to 10 wins, while having the third-best GAA amongst starting goalies (10.31).

Under the direction of Kelusky, Panther City, in its short history has had four different players win the NLL Rookie of the Week honors for a total of 10 times (Donville 5x, Patrick Dodds: 3x, Dean Fairall & Mathieu Gautiuer).

Panther City Lacrosse Club had one of the most successful seasons ever for an expansion club in NLL history in their inaugural campaign in 2021-22. Panther City won seven games, which was more wins than the previous two expansion teams combined and also oversaw a five-game winning streak and had the team in the playoff hunt up until the final weekend of the season.

For his work, Kelusky was awarded the 2021-22 Les Bartley NLL Head Coach of the Year Award. Kelusky is the first head coach of an expansion team to win Coach of the Year honors since Derek Keenan won the award for the Portland Lumberjax in 2006.

In 2021-22, Kelusky adjusted mid-season to make Panther City one of the NLL's most potent offenses, especially on the man advantage, as the team finished in the top half in the league on the power play and on the penalty kill. Kelusky's offense also recorded the highest scoring output in the NLL in 2021-22 as they team recorded 20 goals against the eventual 2021-22 NLL Champions, the Colorado Mammoth.

Kelusky is a long-standing NLL veteran from Peterborough, Ontario, compiling 383 goals, 440 assists and 823 points during his illustrious 14-year career. After announcing his retirement from the NLL, he joined the coaching ranks of the New England Blackwolves before moving on to the Philadelphia Wings to serve as their offensive coach.



### **HEAD COACH**

In addition to his work with the NLL, Kelusky has served as an assistant coach with the Peterborough Lakers of Major Series Lacrosse, and he was also an assistant coach with Finland during the FIL World Indoor Lacrosse Championships in 2015.

The No. 1 overall pick in the 2000 NLL Entry Draft, Kelusky was the Rookie of the Year in 2001, and went on to become a five-time NLL All Star, the All-Star MVP in 2005 and a NLL Sportsmanship Award winner in 2007. Kelusky also has considerable postseason experience, netting 37 goals, 30 assists and 67 points over the course of 16 playoff games. His 37 playoff goals rank ninth all time in NLL history and helped lead Calgary to NLL Championships in 2004 and 2009. In September of 2016, Kelusky was inducted into the National Lacrosse League Hall of Fame during his second stint on the ballot for his extraordinary contributions. In November of 2023, Kelusky was inducted into the Ontario Lacrosse Hall of Fame.

In addition to NLL success, Kelusky also displayed dominance internationally and in other lacrosse organizations. He racked up 499 points in 159 regular season games with Major Series Lacrosse and Western Lacrosse Association teams from 1993-2013 and was a member of the Canadian team that won the 2003 FIL World Indoor Lacrosse Championship. He also captured gold indoors with Team Canada in 2007 and 2011 and Silver at the 2002 World Lacrosse Championships.

A former University of Hartford standout, Kelusky still holds the program record for goals in a season (59 in 2000, goals per game in a season (4.21 in 2000), the top mark for points per game in a season (5.93 in 2000) and stands second in all-time career goals (139), points (209) and single season point total (83 in 2000). He was inducted into the University of Hartford Alumni Hall of Fame in 2006.

Kelusky, who owns Evolve Elite Lacrosse, lives in Peterborough, Ontario with his wife Emily and son Kellar.



STEVE TOLL
DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Steve Toll enters his third season as the Defensive Coordinator for the Panther City Lacrosse Club.

In his second season overseeing the defensive unit, Panther City finished tied for fourth in the NLL in goals against average (10.72). Additionally, Goalie Nick Damude finished third in the NLL in goals against average with a GAA of 10.31. Damude allowed the fewest goals in a single game in the '22-23 season when he only allowed three goals against Las Vegas on 12/16, which made him only the fifth goalie in NLL history to allow three or fewer goals in a full regular-season game. Defenseman Matt Hossack also finished seventh in the NLL amongst defenders with 28 caused turnovers while also scooping 111 loose balls to lead the defense

In his first season overseeing the defense, Toll oversaw a unit that was led by Liam Byrnes who finished fifth amongst NLL defenders with 137 loose balls and tenth in the NLL with 26 caused turnovers.

Toll won the NLL Championship five times during his illustrious 14 year playing career, four times with the Toronto Rock and once with the Rochester Knighthawks. In addition to his time in Toronto and Rochester, Toll played for Edmonton, Colorado, San Jose, and Ontario. Toll was named the first-ever National Lacrosse League Transition Player of the Year in 2007. In 2023, he was inducted into the NLL Hall of Fame.

After retiring from the NLL in 2011, Toll served as the Director of Operations for teams in the Canadian Lacrosse League. In addition to his NLL success, Toll was inducted into the City of St. Catharine's Hall of Fame in 2018 and is a two-time member of the Team Canada World Indoor Lacrosse Gold Medal Team.



# KYLE GOUNDREY

OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Kyle Goundrey is entering his second season as the Offensive Coordinator for the Panther City Lacrosse Club.

In his first season as Offensive Coordinator, Goundrey oversaw the Panther City power-play unit that finished fourth in the NLL and recorded the second-most power play goals (44). He also oversaw the development of 2023 NLL Rookie of the Year Jonathan Donville who led all rookies in points (90) and assists (67), while leading the NLL with 29 power play assists. Will Malcom finished the season with 96 points (35G/61A) and became the first player in Panther City Lacrosse Club history to record a 90+ point season.

Goundrey served as the Western Scout for Panther City during the 2021-22 campaign after playing 11 years in the National Lacrosse League. He most recently served as the Head Coach for the Delta Islanders of the British Columbia Junior A Lacrosse League.







## PANTHER CITY LACROSSE CLUB - DICKIES ARENA

Panther City Lacrosse Club will call Dickies Arena home, a 14,000 seat, spectacular multipurpose venue located adjacent to the Will Rogers Memorial Center campus in Fort Worth, Texas. The facility is the result of a pioneering public-private partnership between the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, the State of Texas and a group of private-sector participants, including foundations, individuals and organizations.

The arena is owned by the City of Fort Worth and managed by the not-for-profit operating entity, Trail Drive Management Corp (TDMC). The state-of-the-art arena hosts concerts, sporting events and family entertainment, and is home to Fort Worth Stock Show Rodeo performances.



## PANTHER CITY LACROSSE CLUB - ABOUT THE NLL

Founded in 1986, the NLL ranks third in average attendance for pro indoor sports worldwide, behind only the NHL and NBA. The League is comprised of 15 franchises across the United States and Canada: Albany FireWolves, Buffalo Bandits, Calgary Roughnecks, Colorado Mammoth, Georgia Swarm, Halifax Thunderbirds, Las Vegas Desert Dogs, New York Riptide, Panther City Lacrosse Club (Fort Worth, TX), Philadelphia Wings, Rochester Knighthawks, San Diego Seals, Saskatchewan Rush, Toronto Rock, and Vancouver Warriors.

According to recent research, the NLL fan is younger (average age 46) than almost every North American professional sports league. Almost 60% of its fans come from a non-lacrosse fan base, while the general lacrosse fan has become more engaged than at any point in the history of the league. #### **Credentials**

Requests for all credentials must go through the Panther City Lacrosse Club communications department. Single-game credentials will be granted to media with a written request submitted at least 48 hours prior to game time. To request accreditation, contact a member of the Panther City Lacrosse Club Communications Department or submit the "Media Inquiry" form found on our website. Submitting a request does not guarantee accreditation.

## Media Parking, Entrance and Seating

Media may park in the Chevrolet Garage on floors 1, 5 or 6. Once parked, use the elevator to go to Floor 3 and cross the bridge to the arena. Enter at the Media/Box Office Entrance on the SW Corner of the Arena.

When entering the arena be ready to show credentials, walk through metal detector and go through quick bag check. After clearing security, take the elevator (#2) to the right and proceed to the appropriate floor:

EL – For Event Level Photog Access and Media Work Room

GL - For Press and Media Seating (Section 207)

## **Photographers**

Only those photographers on assignment will be allowed access to designated photography locations at floor level and in overhead positions. Photography positions will be assigned by the Panther City Lacrosse Club and all photographers must receive accreditation to photograph games.

## **Locker Rooms**

Requests for individual interviews must go through the Panther City Lacrosse Club communications staff. Locker rooms are off-limits to the media at all times.
