The **Panther City Lacrosse Club** (8-8) will close out their home regular season slate on Sunday, April 14 at 4:00 p.m. CT on ESPNU against the **Albany FireWolves** (10-6). Ron Thulin (PxP), Dalton Jernigan (Analyst) and Maggie Hale (Floor Reporter) will be on the nationally televised call.

PCLC VS. ALB GAME PREVIEW

Panther City is coming off of a big, 12-10, win over Philadelphia last week that saw the offense come alive at just the right time as the team enters a crucial end of the season stretch with playoffs looming. The team took a franchise record 66 shots on goal, including a single-game franchise record 20 shots by **Callum Crawford** (5 points - 2G/3A). The team tied the franchise record with six power play goals, of which they also did against Las Vegas (1/27/24).

Rookie **Jason Knox** was the leader on offense as he recorded a career high eight points (4G/4A), including three power play goals, which tied the franchise record for most power play goals in a single game (Patrick Dodds - 2/24/23 at Colorado). Knox's three PPG also ties the league high this season in the NLL. Knox was awarded the NLL Rookie of the Week for his performance in Week 19.

Second-year forward **Jonathan Donville** notched the game winner against Philadelphia for PCLC with just under three minutes remaining in the game. It was Donville's fourth game-winning goal of the 2023-24 season, which is tied for the most GWG in the NLL this season. Donville's game winning goals include two overtime game winners this season.

Albany enters Fort Worth currently in third place in the league and is led by rookies Alex Simmons (85 points - 33G/52A) and Tye Kurtz (66 points - 29G/37A). Goalie Doug Jamieson is having another successful season as he has 10 wins under his belt and has posted a GAA of 10.14.

Both teams will feature some familiar faces as PCLC original team member Nathan Grenon returns to town after spending his first two years in the league with Panther City. Tony Malcom and Brent Mitchell both have spent time in their careers with Albany before heading south to Fort Worth.

Panther City Lacrosse Club Powers Past Albany FireWolves

The Panther City Lacrosse Club (9-6) defeated the Albany FireWolves (2-12), 12-8, tonight at Dickies Arena in Fort Worth. It was a well-balanced attack from the home club as 16 players registered a point.

Callum Crawford (4A) and Will Malcom (2G/2A) led the club with four points, while Patrick Dodds and Phil Caputo also recorded two goals on the evening. Transition player Josh Medeiros extended his scoring streak as he has now scored a goal in seven straight games.

Tyler Burton set the tone tonight as he went 15-19 (78.9%) from the face-off dot, while also leading the team with 11 loose balls. He also recorded an assist.

Defensively, goalie Nick Damude shined again between the pipes as he stopped 32 of 40 shots (80%) he faced and for the fifth straight game recorded an assist as he finished with two assists on the evening. Tonight was the sixth game this season Damude has allowed single-digit goals. Team captain Matt Hossack led the team with two caused turnovers and extended his team lead as he has now recorded 22 caused turnovers for the year.

Clutch Gene

Forward Jonathan Donville has stepped up this season with the game on the line, as he has recorded four game winning goals, two in OT, of which is tied for the most game winning goals scored in the NLL. Donville has five GWG for his career with PCLC.

Milestones Malcs

Will Malcom is looking to become Panther City's first 100-point scorer in a single season. He currently has 95 points (33G/62A).

Malcom is also one goal shy of recording his 100th career goal and one loose ball shy of 300 for his career. Malcom recorded 114 loose balls last season, which was 5th best among NLL forwards.

Roaring Rookies

Under the direction of General Manager Bob Hamley and Head Coach Tracey Kelusky, Panther City has had six different players win the NLL Rookie of the Week honors for a total of 13 times.

Jonathan Donville was named the 2022-23 NLL Rookie of the Year as well as being named to the NLL All-Rookie Team. Patrick Dodds was named to the 2021-22 NLL All-Rookie Team in PCLC's innaugural season.

Most recently, Jason Knox was named NLL Rookie of the Week (Week 19) after posting 10 points (5G/5A) in two games, including an eight-point performance (4G/4A) against Philadelphia (4/7)

Annual Tradition

Goalie Nick Damude recorded his third career goal against Buffalo (3/22). Damude became the second goalie ever in NLL history to record a goal in three consecutive seasons, joining Pat O'Toole (2001-2003). He is also one of just four goalies in the history of the league to record three career goals.

Magnificent Malcs

Will Malcom is Panther City's leading scorer this year and one of the team's most prolific threats out of the front door, but is also finding ways to become a complete player.

Malcom is one of three forwards in the NLL to record at least 80 loose balls and seven caused turnovers (Buffalo's Dhane Smith & Toronto's Challen Rogers). Both Smith and Malcom are their respective club's point scorers.

Malcom is two loose balls away from joining the 30-60-90 (goals, assists, loose balls) club for the second consecutive season. He currently has 33 goals, 62 assists and 88 loose balls.

CC Chasing History

Callum Crawford recorded two power play goals agaisnt the Philadelphia Wings (4/7) to bring his season total to 13 PPG, continuing to raise his career high and also set a new Panther City franchise record for most power play goals in a single season. Phil Caputo previously held the record with 12, which he accomplished last season.

Crawford also broke Will Malcom's franchise record for most goals scored in a single season (35), as he has notched 37 goals through 14 games with two games remaining.



Marchin Into Malcom

In five games in March, Will Malcom averaged seven points per game. He currently leads PCLC with 83 points and 52 assists.

Caputo Comes Clutch

Against Philadelphia (3/10), Phil Caputo netted the game winner for PCLC in OT. This was Caputo's sixth game-winning goal in 48 career games with Panther City.

Caputo is the franchise leader in game-winning goals and power play goals (26). He is second in franchise history with his 80 career goals with PCLC.

Malcom Will Sock Ya

Will Malcom netted seven goals vs. Rochester (3/3/24), for his first career sock trick, as well as set a new career high in goals scored. His previous career high in goals scored was five, which he accomplished twice last season (1/28/23 at VAN & 3/4/23 vs. SASK). He is now three goals away from 100 career goals scored.

Nicky Netminder

Against the San Diego Seals (3/1), goalie Nick Damude turned in one his best performances as a pro, setting a career high with 59 saves, which is also a franchise record for most saves in a single game. Damdue had a 85.5% save percentage, which was just shy of his career high (90.9%), which he set last season in Las Vegas (12/16/22).

The saves (59), shots on goal (69) and save percentage (85.5%) vs. San Diego are all season highs for Damude.

The 59 saves are a season high in the NLL through Week 14.

Hundo!

Callum Crawford, in his 18th season in the NLL, recorded his 100th power play goal of his career against Georgia (2/25). He currently leads PCLC with 13 power play goals.

His 105 power play goals are the eighth most in NLL history and he is one of nine players to record at least 100 power play goals in league history, including being one of four current active NLL players (HFX Ryan Benesch, SASK Robert Church & SD Dane Dobbie) to accomplish the feat.

In the same game, Crawford eclipsed 100 points during his tenure with Panther City and became the fastest player in franchise history to eclipse 100 points, doing so in 19 games. Jonathan Donville previously held the record recording 100 points with the team in 20 games.

Regal Rookie

Rookie foward Ryan Sheridan had his breakout performance of the '23-'24 season in Week 11 against Colorado (2/9/24) as he recorded six points (5G/1A). Sheridan's 5 goals tie a franchise record for most goals in a single game by a rookie (Patrick Dodds 3/11/22 vs. COL)

For his efforts, Sheridan was named NLL Rookie of the Week (Week 11). This was the second time this season Panther City had had a member of their rookie class take home the weekly honor (Jason Knox - Week 7)

Offensive Onslaught

Since their inception in 2021-22, Panther City has recorded 20+ goals three times over the course of their first three seasons.

This is the most 20+ goal performances by a team across the NLL in that time span, and of the other teams that have scored 20+ goals during that span, no other team has accomplished this more than once.

Blackjack!

Against the Las Vegas Desert Dogs (1/27/24), Panther City broke their franchise record for goals in a single game as they scored 21 goals. PCLC has accomplished 20+ goals three times in their three years, including being one of four teams to record 20+ goals last year.

In addition to the goals record, the team also set franchise records for points (58), assists (37) and power play assists (11). Their six power play goals tied a franchise record.

Callum Crawford, Ladies and Gentlemen

Callum Crawford had a historic performance against the Las Vegas Desert Dogs (1/27). Below are his accomplishments from that game:

- Became the only player in NLL history to record multiple 14-point games (Prev: 12/27/19 NE vs. NY).
- Tied his career high with 14 points (8G/6A).
- Set a new career high with 8 goals.
- Became the 7th player in NLL history to record at least 8 goals in a single regular season game

• His 12 first-half points (6G/6A) are the most points scored in a half in league history.

• Became the 18th player in league history to appear in at least 250 career games.

• Named the NLL Player of the Week (Week 9) - First PCLC player to ever win Player of the Week honors.

Crawf Continues To Crush

In 24 games with PCLC, Crawford has now scored five or more goals in a single game three times.

In Week 9 against Las Vegas, Crawford recorded eight goals, his fifth game this season with three or more goals. Crawford has recorded eight hat tricks in 22 career games with Panther City.

Dynamic Duo

With Callum Crawford's 14 points and Will Malcom's 12 points against Las Vegas (1/27), the PCLC pair tied an NLL record for most combined points between a set of teammates (26). They tied Mark Steenhuis (17 points) and Cory Bomberry (9 points) who accomplished this feat in 2009. (h/t Graeme Perrow / @ NLLStats)

Callum Chasing Greatness

Against Colorado (2/9), Crawford scored his 480th career goal, which gave him sole possesion of 9th place all time in NLL history for most goals scored, passing Shawn Evans.

Crawford became the eighth player in NLL history to record 1,200 points in his career against Las Vegas (12/10).

Through 258 career games, Crawford now ranks in the top 10 all time in NLL history for goals (9th - 491 goals), assists (6th - 784 assists) and points (8th -1,275 points). Crawford is one of two current active players (HFX Ryan Benesch) that are in the top 10 offensively all time statistically in NLL history.

Milestones Reached

Forward Jonathan Doville recorded his 100th career point against Las Vegas (12/10) in just his 20th NLL game.

Forward Will Malcom recorded his 200th career point against Toronto on 12/22 as he recorded five points (2G/3A).

Will Malcom surpassed 200 career points in a Panther City uniform against Las Vegas (1/27). In his debut season with PCLC, Malcom notched 81 points, only to then set the franchise record for points in a single season in year two with the club (96 points).

Malcom Making Moves

Since joining the Panther City Lacrosse Club, forward Will Malcom has been one of the club's most consistent offensive threats. Malcom has recorded a point in every game he has played in in a Panther City jersey (51 games) and has scored a goal in 46 of the 51 games he has played in.

Rookie of the Year Records

Jonathan Donville's 67 assists last season were the second-most ever by a rookie in NLL history and only trailed New York's Jeff Teat (71 - 2022).

BOB HADLEY GENERAL MANAGER & VICE PRESIDENT OF LACROSSSE OPERATIONS

Bob Hamley, a 20-year plus veteran of the National Lacrosse League, serves as the Vice President of Lacrosse Operations and General Manager for the Panther City Lacrosse Club. He joined the club in September of 2020.

Hamley is responsible for the hiring of Head Coach Tracey Kelusky, the 2022 Les Bartley NLL Coach of the Year winner and through his roster construction helped Panther City qualify to their first double-digit win campaign, tallying a 10-8 record and qualifying for the playoffs for the first time in franchise history by finishing as the third seed in the Western Conference in 2022-23. In their inaugural season, Panther City recorded more wins than the previous two NLL expansion clubs' first seasons combined, as

Panther City won seven games, including a five-game winning streak. For his efforts in 2021-22, Hamley was named a finalist for the 2022 NLL General Manger of the Year Award.

Hamley's ability to scout and develop talent, while also acquiring and signing impact players has been at the forefront of Panther City's success and allowed the team to be competitive from their very first day. He drafted Jonathan Donville first overall with the team's first ever NLL Entry Draft selection in 2021. Donville took home the NLL Rookie of the Year award in 2022-23 after leading all rookies in points (90), which were the fourth-most ever by a rookie in NLL history, and assists (67), which were the second-most ever by a rookie in NLL history. He finished second amongst rookies with 23 goals. For his efforts, Donville was named NLL Rookie of the Week five times this past season, more than any other rookie in the league. Donville finished 9th in the NLL with 67 assists and his 29 power play assists were the most in the league and he finished tied for second in the NLL with 31 power play points. Under the direction of Hamley, Panther City, in its short history has had four different players win the NLL Rookie of the Week honors for a total of 10 times (Donville 5x, Patrick Dodds: 3x, Dean Fairall & Mathieu Gautiuer). In 2021-22, Hamley acquired four rookies who finished in the top-20 in rookie points, including All-Rookie Team member, Patrick Dodds, who finished second amongst rookies in scoring in 2021-22.

Hamley has also had success outside of the draft, acquiring or signing players that have had made an instant impact on the team and asserted themselves as some of the best at their position in the NLL. Will Malcom was acquired prior to the 2021-22 season and in 2022-23, Malcom led the team with 96 points (35G/61A), which was the first 90+ point season in franchise history and his goals and assists totals were both top 15 in the league. Goalie Nick Damude was also a key acquisition for Hamley as the goalie has improved each year since arriving in Panther City. Last season, Damude finished third in the NLL in Goals Against Average (GAA) with a GAA of 10.31. Damude allowed the fewest goals in a single game in the '22-23 season when he only allowed three goals against Las Vegas on 12/16, which made him only the fifth goalie in NLL history to allow three or fewer goals in a full regular-season game. Also defensively, Hamley acquired defenseman Matt Hossack in the 2021 NLL Expansion Draft. Hossack finished seventh in the NLL in caused turnovers (28) in 2022-23, while also recording 111 loose balls. Transition Player Josh Medeiros was signed as a free agent prior to the start of Panther City's inaugural season and in 2022-23 led all transition players with 21 goals, nearly tripling his rookie season goal output (8 goals in '21-22), en route to numerous career highs such as goals, loose balls (91) and caused turnovers (12).

BOB HADLEY GENERAL MANAGER & VICE PRESIDENT OF LACROSSSE OPERATIONS

Hamley played in the NLL for four years and won back-to-back championships with the Buffalo Bandits in 1992-1993. Following his playing career, Hamley has enjoyed a successful run as Head Coach and or General Manager for 16 years throughout the league.

Prior to joining Panther City, Hamley served as the National Director of 3D Lacrosse in Georgia where he was responsible for the company's day-to-day operations. Here he helped develop the game of lacrosse, young players and coaches in market and assisted high school lacrosse players pursue scholarships at the collegiate level. Through Hamley's extensive nation-wide lacrosse network he was able to help place players at Michigan, John's Hopkins, Albany and Air Force.

From 2010-2014, Hamley was the Head Coach and Director of Player Personnel for the Colorado Mammoth. The team made the playoffs every year of Hamley's tenure and he was a part of the personnel department that drafted 2011 NLL Rookie of the Year Adam Jones. From 2008-2009, Hamley served as the Head Coach and General Manager for the Edmonton Rush.

Hamley was named the Head Coach and General Manager of the Columbus Landsharks in 2002 and remained with the team as they relocated to Arizona as the Arizona Sting. He remained with the team until 2008. During his tenure with the Sting, Hamley was named the Head Coach and General Manager of the Year in 2005, the first time the award was given to the one person in the same year. The team made the NLL Western Finals three straight years from 2005-07 and reached the championship game in 2005 and 2007.

In 2001, Hamley received his first shot on the bench as he was named an assistant coach with the Albany Attack. The team reached the NLL Championship game in his first season.

The Owen Sound, Ontario native currently resides in Fort Worth with his wife, Lisa and the couple have two children, Brock and Kelsea.





RACEY **USKY** HEAD COACH

Tracey Kelusky (25-26) enters his third season as the Head Coach of the Panther City Lacrosse Club.

In 2022-23, in his second season at the helm of Panther City, Kelusky led the team to 10 wins, the first double-digit wins campaign in franchise history and also secured a playoff spot in just the team's second season, by finishing in third place in the Western Conference. As a team, Kelusky oversaw a power-play unit that finished fourth in the NLL and recorded the second-most power play goals (44). Kelusky also oversaw the development of 2023 NLL Rookie of the Year Jonathan Donville who led all rookies in points (90) and assists (67), while leading the NLL with 29 power play assists. Kelusky was also instrumental in the growth

of third-year forward Will Malcom who finished the season with 96 points (35G/61A) and became the first player in Panther City Lacrosse Club history to record a 90+ point season. Defensively, goalie Nick Damude took a massive step forward this season and helped lead the team to 10 wins, while having the third-best GAA amongst starting goalies (10.31).

Under the direction of Kelusky, Panther City, in its short history has had four different players win the NLL Rookie of the Week honors for a total of 10 times (Donville 5x, Patrick Dodds: 3x, Dean Fairall & Mathieu Gautiuer).

Panther City Lacrosse Club had one of the most successful seasons ever for an expansion club in NLL history in their inaugural campaign in 2021-22. Panther City won seven games, which was more wins than the previous two expansion teams combined and also oversaw a five-game winning streak and had the team in the playoff hunt up until the final weekend of the season.

For his work, Kelusky was awarded the 2021-22 Les Bartley NLL Head Coach of the Year Award. Kelusky is the first head coach of an expansion team to win Coach of the Year honors since Derek Keenan won the award for the Portland Lumberjax in 2006.

In 2021-22, Kelusky adjusted mid-season to make Panther City one of the NLL's most potent offenses, especially on the man advantage, as the team finished in the top half in the league on the power play and on the penalty kill. Kelusky's offense also recorded the highest scoring output in the NLL in 2021-22 as they team recorded 20 goals against the eventual 2021-22 NLL Champions, the Colorado Mammoth.

Kelusky is a long-standing NLL veteran from Peterborough, Ontario, compiling 383 goals, 440 assists and 823 points during his illustrious 14-year career. After announcing his retirement from the NLL, he joined the coaching ranks of the New England Blackwolves before moving on to the Philadelphia Wings to serve as their offensive coach.



RACFY **USKY** HEAD COACH

In addition to his work with the NLL, Kelusky has served as an assistant coach with the Peterborough Lakers of Major Series Lacrosse, and he was also an assistant coach with Finland during the FIL World Indoor Lacrosse Championships in 2015.

The No. 1 overall pick in the 2000 NLL Entry Draft, Kelusky was the Rookie of the Year in 2001, and went on to become a five-time NLL All Star, the All-Star MVP in 2005 and a NLL Sportsmanship Award winner in 2007. Kelusky also has considerable postseason experience, netting 37 goals, 30 assists and 67 points over the course of 16 playoff games. His 37 playoff goals rank ninth all time in NLL history and helped lead Calgary to NLL Championships in 2004 and 2009. In September of 2016, Kelusky was inducted into the National Lacrosse League Hall of Fame during his second stint on the ballot for his extraordinary contributions. In November of 2023, Kelusky was inducted into the Ontario Lacrosse Hall of Fame.

In addition to NLL success, Kelusky also displayed dominance internationally and in other lacrosse organizations. He racked up 499 points in 159 regular season games with Major Series Lacrosse and Western Lacrosse Association teams from 1993-2013 and was a member of the Canadian team that won the 2003 FIL World Indoor Lacrosse Championship. He also captured gold indoors with Team Canada in 2007 and 2011 and Silver at the 2002 World Lacrosse Championships.

A former University of Hartford standout, Kelusky still holds the program record for goals in a season (59 in 2000, goals per game in a season (4.21 in 2000), the top mark for points per game in a season (5.93 in 2000) and stands second in all-time career goals (139), points (209) and single season point total (83 in 2000). He was inducted into the University of Hartford Alumni Hall of Fame in 2006.

Kelusky, who owns Evolve Elite Lacrosse, lives in Peterborough, Ontario with his wife Emily and son Kellar.







Steve Toll enters his third season as the Defensive Coordinator for the Panther City Lacrosse Club.

In his second season overseeing the defensive unit, Panther City finished tied for fourth in the NLL in goals against average (10.72). Additionally, Goalie Nick Damude finished third in the NLL in goals against average with a GAA of 10.31. Damude allowed the fewest goals in a single game in the '22-23 season when he only allowed three goals against Las Vegas on 12/16, which made him only the fifth goalie in NLL history to allow three or fewer goals in a full regular-season game. Defenseman Matt Hossack also finished seventh in the NLL amongst defenders with 28 caused turnovers while also scooping 111 loose balls to lead the defense

In his first season overseeing the defense, Toll oversaw a unit that was led by Liam Byrnes who finished fifth amongst NLL defenders with 137 loose balls and tenth in the NLL with 26 caused turnovers.

Toll won the NLL Championship five times during his illustrious 14 year playing career, four times with the Toronto Rock and once with the Rochester Knighthawks. In addition to his time in Toronto and Rochester, Toll played for Edmonton, Colorado, San Jose, and Ontario. Toll was named the first-ever National Lacrosse League Transition Player of the Year in 2007. In 2023, he was inducted into the NLL Hall of Fame.

After retiring from the NLL in 2011, Toll served as the Director of Operations for teams in the Canadian Lacrosse League. In addition to his NLL success, Toll was inducted into the City of St. Catharine's Hall of Fame in 2018 and is a two-time member of the Team Canada World Indoor Lacrosse Gold Medal Team.





KYLE **IDREY** OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Kyle Goundrey is entering his second season as the Offensive Coordinator for the Panther City Lacrosse Club.

In his first season as Offensive Coordinator, Goundrey oversaw the Panther City power-play unit that finished fourth in the NLL and recorded the second-most power play goals (44). He also oversaw the development of 2023 NLL Rookie of the Year Jonathan Donville who led all rookies in points (90) and assists (67), while leading the NLL with 29 power play assists. Will Malcom finished the season with 96 points (35G/61A) and became the first player in Panther City Lacrosse Club history to record a 90+ point season.

Goundrey served as the Western Scout for Panther City during the 2021-22 campaign after playing 11 years in the National Lacrosse League. He most recently served as the Head Coach for the Delta Islanders of the British Columbia Junior A Lacrosse League.

A left-handed forward from Richmond, British Columbia, Goundrey won two NLL Championships with the Calgary Roughnecks in 2004 and 2009 and for his career, totaled 312 points on 97 goals and 215 assists. Goundrey and Panther City Head Coach Tracey Kelusky were teammates on both championship runs with Calgary and the two have a long history of being teammates with one another, as they also both played Junior A lacrosse together in Peterborough, Ontario.







PANTHER CITY LACROSSE CLUB - DICKIES ARENA

Panther City Lacrosse Club will call Dickies Arena home, a 14,000 seat, spectacular multipurpose venue located adjacent to the Will Rogers Memorial Center campus in Fort Worth, Texas. The facility is the result of a pioneering public-private partnership between the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, the State of Texas and a group of private-sector participants, including foundations, individuals and organizations.

The arena is owned by the City of Fort Worth and managed by the not-for-profit operating entity, Trail Drive Management Corp (TDMC). The state-of-the-art arena hosts concerts, sporting events and family entertainment, and is home to Fort Worth Stock Show Rodeo performances.



PANTHER CITY LACROSSE CLUB - ABOUT THE NLL

Founded in 1986, the NLL ranks third in average attendance for pro indoor sports worldwide, behind only the NHL and NBA. Credentials

Requests for all credentials must go through the Panther City Lacrosse Club communications department. Single-game credentials will be granted to media with a written request submitted at least 48 hours prior to game time. Submitting a request does not guarantee accreditation.

Media Parking, Entrance and Seating

Media may park in the Chevrolet Garage on floors 1, 5 or 6. Once parked, use the elevator to go to Floor 3 and cross the bridge to the arena. Enter at the Media/Box Office Entrance on the SW Corner of the Arena.

When entering the arena be ready to show credentials, walk through metal detector and go through quick bag check. After clearing security, take the elevator (#2) to the right and proceed to the appropriate floor:

EL – For Event Level Photog Access and Media Work Room

GL – For Press and Media Seating (Section 207)

Photographers

Only those photographers on assignment will be allowed access to designated photography locations at floor level and in overhead positions. Photography positions will be assigned by the Panther City Lacrosse Club and all photographers must receive accreditation to photograph games.

Locker Rooms

Requests for individual interviews must go through the Panther City Lacrosse Club communications staff. Locker rooms are off-limits to the media at all times.
